Dateline: Cumberland County – Sheriff's Gun Lock Stop Planned

Due to wet weather conditions forecast last week, Cumberland County Sheriff Earl R. Butler decided to reschedule the second leg of a campaign stop to distribute free gun locks.

The stop **has been rescheduled for Friday, February 12, 2010.** At that time, the mobile unit will be located at the Sheriff's Office Substation at 1007 Honeycutt Road in Eureka Springs, from 8:00 a.m. until 10:00 a.m. Later in the day, the mobile unit will relocate to the East Regional Library on Clinton Road from 2:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m.

On Thursday, February 4, 2010 Sheriff's Deputies set up the Mobile Command Post and distributed approximately 600 free gun locks. The campaign is designed to promote gun safety by securing weapons in homes where there are young children.
