Dateline: Man Arrested Following Disturbance Inside Social Services Building

Cumberland County Sheriff's Deputies have arrested a Fayetteville man after he allegedly threatened his girlfriend via cell phone messages.

19-year old Jordan Tywayne Mitchell of 6826 Marlowe Drive allegedly followed 19-year old Stephanie Malanu inside the Cumberland County Department of Social Services building shortly before 3:00 p.m. today. Malanu claims Mitchell told her he had a gun and he was going to kill her.

Sheriff's Deputies were called to the scene where Malanu was holed up inside a room on the third floor of the facility and Mitchell roamed the first floor searching for her. Mitchell ran from the building when deputies arrived. He was apprehended a few blocks away when the vehicle he was riding in was pulled over near Ramsey Street. Deputies say they did not find a weapon in Mitchell's possession.

Mitchell will be taken to the Cumberland County Detention Center where he will be charged with communicating threats. Meanwhile, the Hope Mills Police Department has also filed warrants against Mitchell.
